
6. Look at the pictures given below. Write a sentence on each using an adjective. Then, write whether the adjective shows the quality or quantity of the noun. One is done for you.





Recap

- Words that describe nouns are called adjectives.
- Adjectives that give us information about the quantity or position of a noun
 (how much/how many/first/second/last) are called quantitative adjectives.
 For example, some, many, few, three
- Adjectives that describe the quality of a noun (what kind/type) are called qualitative adjectives. For example, sweet, tall, red, park, navelus, cold
