3) What is Duma?

Duma was an elected consultative parliament which Tsar allowed to create after the 1905 revolution.

4) What was the causes of 1905 revolution?

Ans) Reasons for 1905 revolution:-

- > Prices of essential goods rose so quickly that real wages declined by 20 percent.
- > Four members of the Assembly of Russian workers, were dismissed at the Putilov iron workers.
- > There was a call for industrial action. Over the next few days over 110,000 workers in St-Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction in working day to eight hours, an increase in wages and improvement of working conditions.
- > When the procession of workers led by Gapon reached near Winter Palace it was attacked by police and Cossacks. over ~~1000~~ 1000 workers were killed and 300 wounded. This incident was called bloody Sunday. It started a series of "events" called 1905 revolution.
- > Strike took place all over the country by lawyers, doctors etc.
