2) The workers quarters & factories were located on the right bank of river Neva & on left there were fashionable palace, official building, including place where duma met.

5) The workers of 50 factories joined in sympathy.

6) Fashionable quarters & official building were rounded by workers, the govt.

imposed curfew.

- ) On Sunday 25 Feb govt. Suspended the Duma
- ◆ Politician Spoke out against this move, demonstrations returned in force to Streets Ob left bench on 26th
- ) On the Street thronged with people raising Slogans about bread, wages, better hours and democracy.
- ) On 27th police head quarters were ransacked
- ) The govt tried to control the situation, the Cavalry was called but they refused to fire on demonstrators
- ) By that evening Soldiers and Striking Workers had gathered to form Soviet or council in the same building as Duma met. This was Petrograd Soviet.
- ) On the very next day, a delegation went to see Tsar. Military Commanders advised him to abdicate. He followed their advice and abdicated on 2 march.
- ) Duma leaders and Soviet leaders formed a Provisional Govt. to run the Country.



2) Explain what do you mean by Petrograd Soviet?

Petrograd Soviet was a council made by the soldiers and striking workers during the February revolution in Petrograd.
