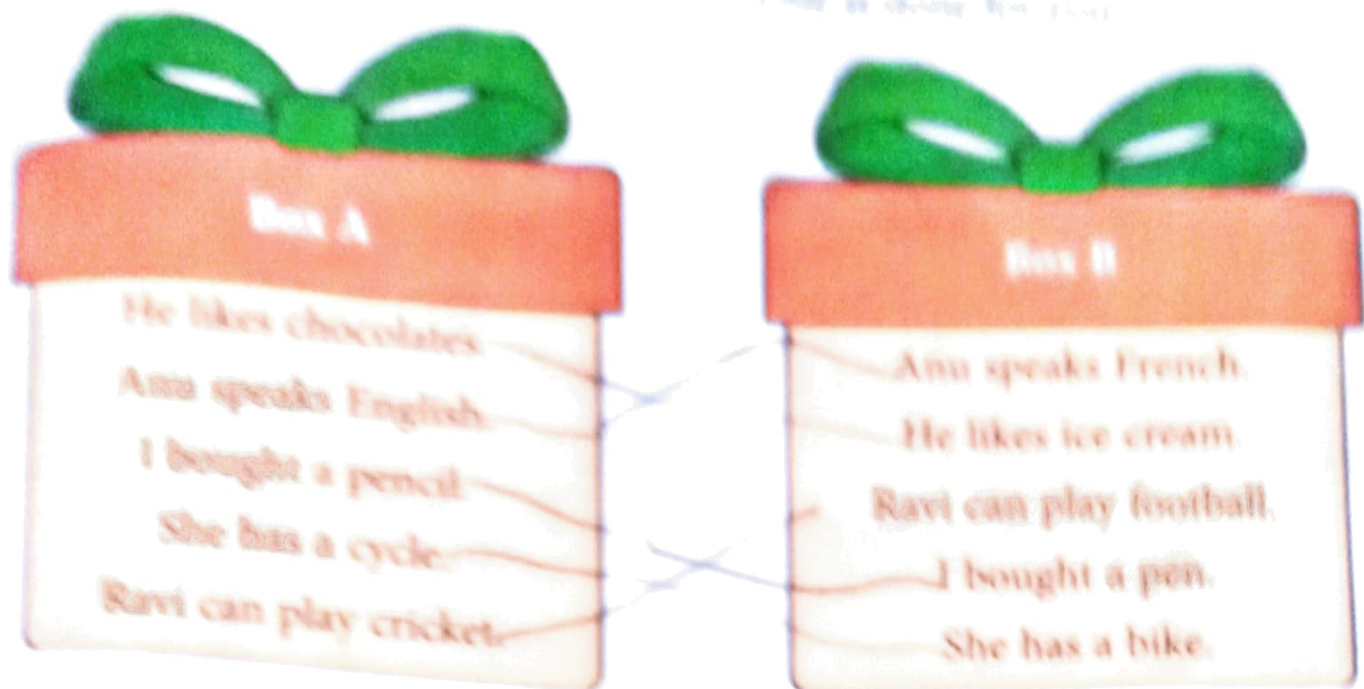


Write the words in Box A with the sentences in Box B, using *and* to connect to the space given below. (Box B shows how to do it.)
