1. Ram will go to Taj Mahal tomorrow.

Negative → Ram willn't go to Taj Mahal tomorrow.

Interrogative → Will Ram go to Taj Mahal tomorrow?

2. The speaker will give the speech in the assembly.

Negative → The speaker willn't give the speech in the assembly.

Interrogative → Will the speaker give the speech in the assembly?

3. I shall visit the Prativa Ashram in the afternoon.

Negative → I shalln't visit the Prativa Ashram in the afternoon.

Interrogative → Shall I visit the Prativa Ashram in the afternoon?

4. They will play football in the field.

Negative → They won't play football in the field.

Interrogative → Will they play football in the field?

5. Bob will go to the library tomorrow.

Negative → Bob won't go to the library tomorrow.

Interrogative → Will Bob go to the library tomorrow?

6. I shall work hard to obtain good marks.

Negative → I shalln't work ^{hard} to obtain good marks.

Interrogative → Shall I work hard to obtain good marks.

7. We shall go to school along.

Negative → We shalln't go to school along.

Interrogative → Shall we go to the school along?

8. Today, I will surely give you mine book.

Negative → Today, I willn't ^{surely} give you mine book.

Interrogative → ~~Will~~ Today, Will I surely give you mine book?

9. Raj and Ram will collect the school fees from the students.

Negative → Raj and Ram willn't collect the school fees from the students.

Interrogative → Will Raj and Ram collect the school fees from the students?

10. My father will buy a new Kia car today.

Negative → My father willnot buy a new Kia car today.

Interrogative → Will my father buy a new Kia car today?

Future Continuous tense :

1. They will be cooking food at this time.

Negative → They won't be cooking food at this time.

Interrogative → Will they be cooking food at this time?

2. He will be learning a new skill.

Negative → He won't be learning a new skill.

Interrogative → Will he be learning a new skill?

3. We shall be eating our lunch.

Negative → We shan't be eating our lunch.

Interrogative → Shall we be eating our lunch?

4. I shall be buying a new mobile.

Negative → I shan't be buying a new mobile.

Interrogative → Shall I be buying a new mobile?

5. Raghav will be studying tonight.

Negative → Raghav won't be studying tonight.

Interrogative → Will Raghav be studying tonight?

6. Virat Kohli will be playing a cricket tournament tomorrow.

Negative → Virat Kohli won't be playing a cricket tournament tomorrow.

Interrogative → Will Virat Kohli be playing a cricket tournament tomorrow?

7. It will be making a sense.

Negative → It won't be making a sense.

Interrogative → Will it be making a sense?

8. Hira Sagar will be listening to the music.

Negative → Hira Sagar willn't be listening to the music.

Interrogative → Will Hira Sagar be listening to the music?

9. She will be driving a scooter.

Negative → She willn't be driving a scooter.

Interrogative → Will she be driving a scooter?

10. I shall be eating pizza.

Negative → I shalln't be eating pizza.

Interrogative → Shall I be eating pizza?
