1. Light is a form of energy that affects our eyes to produce the sensation of vision.
2. The body that emits their own light are called ~~natural~~ natural source of light while the body that do not emit their own light are called ~~natur~~ artificial source of light.
3. The body that emits their own light and shine and glow by their own light are called luminous bodies.

Ex. Sun, stars, a burning candle, etc.

The body that emits their own light, ~~and shine~~ but become visible by the light falling from them from some luminous bodies, are called non-luminous bodies.

Ex. The moon, Earth, a table, a book, a chair, etc.

4. The light travelling in any one direction in a straight line is called a ray of light.
5. A group of light rays given out from a source is called a beam of light.
