

Types Of Animals	Adaptations	Examples
Herbivores	Plant-eating animals are called herbivores. They have sharp biting and strong grinding teeth. They have long and strong legs to travel long distances in search of food.	Cows, goats and giraffes
Carnivores	Flesh-eating animals are called carnivores. They have well-developed tearing teeth. Flesh-eating birds have claws to catch other animals and to tear their flesh.	Lions, tigers, dogs, eagles and vultures
Omnivores	Animals that eat both plants and animals are called omnivores.	Bears, crabs and cockroaches
Parasites	Some animals live on or inside the bodies of other animals for their food. They are called parasites. The animals on which parasites depend for their food are called hosts. They have suckers or sucking tubes to suck blood from their host.	Mosquitoes, leeches, hookworms and bugs
