

- (17) Steps Recorder is the tool that helps in troubleshooting a problem occurring in Windows 10.
- (18) Replacing double click with single click is available under File Explorer option of control panel.
- (19) Utilities are the additional programs of Windows.
- (20) Source program converted into machine language by the translator.
- (21) There are four different animations effects such as Entrance, Exit, Emphasis, and Motion Paths.
- (22) The Effect option in animation group gives different direction options to each transition.
- (23) The animation option in Advanced Animation group copies the animation from one object and applies it to another.

- (24) The recorded sound files have extension .WAV.
- (25) Ctrl + D is the shortcut key to create duplicate slide.
- (26) Action buttons are built-in shapes.
- (27) F2 function key is used to repeat most commands.
- (28) Ctrl + Shift + F short-cut key to apply the outline border around the selected cell.
- (29) To enter data in multiple lines in the same cell, use Alt + Enter key combination.
- (30) The Enter and Cancel buttons are present on the Formula bar.
