- The middle class government in 1848 tried to unite the different regions of the German Confederation into a national state governed by an elected parliament
- Liberals were repressed by the combined force of the monarchy and the military, supported by the large landowners of Prussia
- Prussia took on the leadership of the movement for national unification
- Chief minister, Otto Von Bismarck was the architect of the policy carried out with the help of the Prussian army and bureaucracy
- It took over 7 years with Austria, Denmark and France ended in Prussian victory

- The process of unification of was completed in Jan 1871.

- The Prussian King Wilhelm I was proclaimed German Emperor in a ceremony at Versailles.
