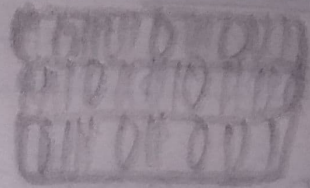


• TYPES OF MUSCULAR TISSUE :-

* On basis of location, structure and function, there are three types :-

→ Striated muscles - (stripped, skeletal or voluntary muscles)



- Usually attached to skeleton

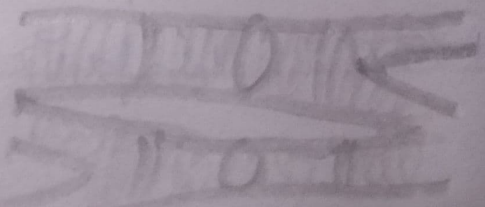
→ Smooth muscles - unstriated, visceral or involuntary muscles.



- Usually covering wall of internal organs

→ Cardiac muscles - striated, branched, involuntary, uninucleated

Only covering wall of the heart.
