③ Describe poverty trends in 1973.

Ans) As per data, there has been substantial decline in poverty ratios in India from 45% in 1993-94 to 37.2% in 2004-05. There was further decline to 22% in 2011-12.

⑥ Give an account of interstate disparities in India.

Ans) * Proportion of poor people is not same in every state.

* Bihar and Odisha had above all India Poverty level (22%).

* Bihar & Odisha continues to be the two poorest states with ratio of 33.7% and 32.6% respectively.

* But states like Punjab, Haryana, Tamilnadu, West Bengal, Kerala and Andhra Pradesh had a significant decline in poverty ratios.

* Punjab & Haryana reduced poverty by Green Revolution.

* West Bengal adopted Land ceiling system.

* In Andhra Pradesh & Tamilnadu food grains were distributed.

* Kerala focused on human resource development which led to significant decline in poverty in these states.
