Ans:- The 1905 revolution was spurred by the Russian defeat in the Russo-Japanese war, which ended in the same year, but also by the growing realization by a variety of sectors of society of the need for reform. Politicians such as Sergei Witte had failed to accomplish this. The impact of the first World War on Russia was immense. In the early stages of the war, the Russian Army suffered huge losses at Tannenberg and at the battle of the Masurian Lakes. The new name of St. Petersburg is Petrograd. Jadidists were Muslim reformers within the Russian Empire who wanted modernized Islam to lead their societies.
