- ① Germany lost its overseas colonies, $\frac{1}{4}$ of its population, 13% of its territories, 75% of its iron & 26% of its coal to France, Poland, Denmark & Lithuania.
- The Allied Powers demilitarized Germany to weaken its power.
 - The war guilt clause held Germany responsible for the war & damages the Allied countries suffered & strained them to pay £6 billion compensation.
 - The armies of Allied Powers occupied the resource-rich Rhineland for most of the 1920s.
