- Most state govt have not transferred significant powers to the local govt.

2- What is Gram Sabha?

3- What are functions of Gram Sabha?

ans-(i) It elects the members of gram panchayat.

(ii) It supervises the work of the village panchayat.

(iii) It approves the annual budget of the panchayat.

(iv) It reviews the performance of the Gram Panchayat.
