

Q1) What is a globe?

Ans:- A globe is a three-dimensional model of the Earth in miniature.

Q2) What do two points one at top and another at bottom denote on a globe?

Ans:- The two points one at top denotes North Pole and ~~the~~ another at bottom denotes South Pole on a globe.

Q3) What do we understand by the term 'Axis of the Earth'?
