1. Temperature increases when we travel closer towards the center of the earth.
2. Pressure increases as we travel down.
3. The 3 main layers of the earth are:
→ Crust → Mantle → Core
4. The earth's crust is made up of the upper crust and the lower crust.

6. The two types of earth's crust are:
Upper crust and lower crust.
7. The ocean crust contains rock that are more dense than the rocks found on land as the land is lighter than oceanic crust and the oceanic crust contains minerals like silica, iron and magnesium.
8. The upper layer of mantle is made of 3 minerals like silica, iron and magnesium. The lower layer of mantle is made up of minerals like iron, magnesium, aluminium and silicon.

9. The crust and the outermost of the upper mantle makes up the lithosphere.

10. Right below the lithosphere there is a layer of mantle that is made of softer rock called the asthenosphere.

11. The mantle is 2,900 km deep.

12. The earth core is divided into 2 parts, they are:

Upper core and inner core.

13. The 2 metals that make up the both parts of core are Iron and Nickel.
