1) Who was the leader of Bolshevik party?

4) What was the result of 1905 Revolution in Russia?

Ans) → The result of 1905 Revolution was that Tsar allowed the creation of an elected consultative Parliament / Duma.

5) Briefly explain the cause for the revolution of 1905 in Russia?

- (a) → Prices of essential goods rose so quickly that real wages declined by 20 per cent.
- Four members of the Assembly of Russian Workers, were dismissed at the Putilov Iron Works, there was a call for industrial action.
- Over the next few days over 110,000 workers in St. Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction in the working day to eight hours, an increase in wages & improvement in working conditions.
- When the procession of workers led by Father Gapon reached the Winter Palace it was attacked by the Police & the Cossacks. Over 100 workers were killed & about 300 wounded. The incident was known as Bloody Sunday.
- All the people from different field joined the strike.
