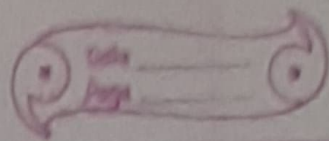

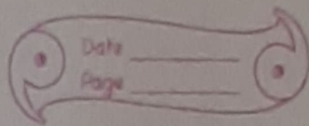
b) How is Macavity outwardly respectable?
