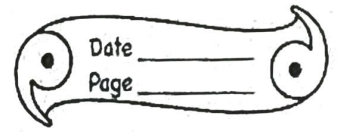

1) Write two differences between Blood & Lymph.

Blood	Lymph.
> It is red in colour due to the presence of hemoglobin red cells.	> It is colourless as red blood cells are absent.
> It moves away from the heart & towards the heart	> It moves in one direction i.e., from tissues to sub clavians

2) How bone differs from cartilage?

<u>Bone</u>	<u>Cartilage</u>
> Bone is a hard connective tissue.	> Cartilage is soft connective tissue.
> Bone is highly vascular.	> Cartilage is non vascular.
> Bone may have bone marrow at the centre.	> No such tissue is present.
