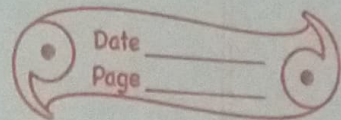

- 1) Who was the leader of Bolshevik party?

When the procession of workers led by Father Gapon reached the Winter Palace it was attacked by the police & Cossacks. Over 100 workers were killed & about 300 wounded. The incident, known as Bloody Sunday.
- 3) What was Duma?
The elected consultative Parliament during 1905 revolution was known as Duma.
- 4) What was the result of 1905 Revolution in Russia?
The result was: During the 1905 Revolution, the Tsar allowed the creation of an elected consultative Parliament or Duma.

5) Briefly explain the causes for the Revolution of 1905 in Russia?

- > Prices of essential goods rose so quickly that real wages declined by 25 percent.
- > When four members of the assembly of Russian Workers, were dismissed at the Putilov Iron Works, there was a call for industrial action.
- > Over the next few days over 110,000 workers in St. Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction in the working day to eight hours, an increase in wages & improvement in working conditions.
- > When the procession of workers led by Father Gapon reached the Winter Palace it was attacked by the police & the Cossacks. Over 100 workers were killed & about 300 wounded. The incident, known as Bloody Sunday, started a series of events that became known as the 1905 Revolution.
- > All the people from different field joined the strike.
