- > The media glorified trench life.
- > Aggressive war, propaganda & national honour occupied centre stage in the public sphere.

> November Criminals were those who supported the Weimar Republic, mainly the socialists, Catholics and Democrats.

> They were called so as they were responsible for signing the Treaty of Versailles, which was a humiliating treaty for Germany on 11 Nov. at 11am.
