Advantages


- Constitutional status for local government has helped to deepen democracy in our country.

- Most state governments have not transferred significant powers to the local government. Nor they have given adequate power.

What is Gram Sabha? Describe any four functions of it.

Gram Sabha is a meeting of a village where all elder members of a particular village discussed all the matters of that village.



The functions of Gram Sabha :-

- (i) It elects the members of the Gram Panchayat.
- (ii) It supervises the work of the Gram Panchayat.
- (iii) It approves the annual budget of the Panchayat.
- (iv) It reviews the performance of Gram Panchayat.
