* Education contributes towards the growth of society.

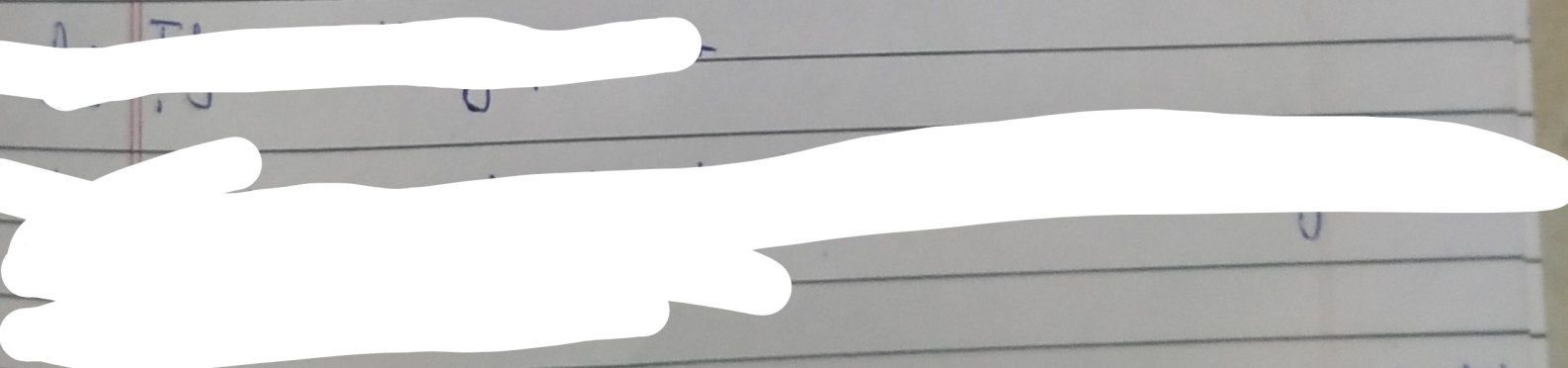
- * It enhances the national income and cultural richness
