Q1. Describe the process of unification of Italy.

- A) i) Italy's unification process was the work of Giuseppe Garibaldi, Count Cavour, & Victor Emmanuel II, the 3 primary leaders.
- ii) Italy was divided into 7 states in which only the Sardinia-Piedmont region was ruled by the princely House of Italy.
- iii) The Second Victory of Emmanuel overcame the forces of France & liberated the Southern areas & completed the unification of Italy, & the Emperor of unified Italy was proclaimed.
- Q2. Describe the process of unification of Germany.

- A) The process of unification of Germany :-
- \* The middle-class Germans had tried to fight for a united nation governed by an elected parliament in 1848 but were repressed by the monarchy & military.
  - \* Otto von Bismarck, chief minister of Prussia led the movement for unification of Germany. He was supported by the bureaucracy & the Prussian army.
  - \* After 3 wars with Austria, Denmark, & France, Prussia won unified Germany. The Prussian king, William I, was proclaimed the German emperor in January 1871.
