

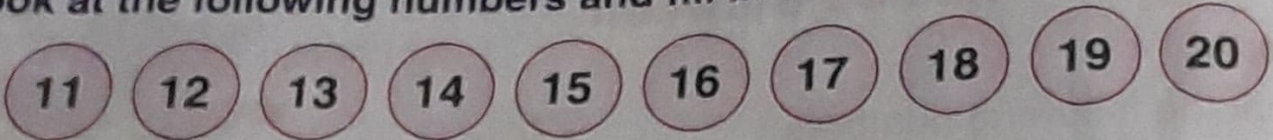
Example 2 : Consider numbers from 53 to 57.



- (a) 54 comes after 53
- (b) 55 comes between 54 and 56.
- (c) 54, 55 and 56 come between 53 and 57.
- (d) 56 comes before 57.
- (e) 54, 55, 56 and 57 come after 53.
- (f) 53, 54, 55 and 56 are before 57.
