Ans. A flower is the most beautiful and colourful part of a plant which serves as a reproductive organ.

Q8) State the location of the following in a flower.

Ans. Sepals : Sepals are the green outermost part of a flower.

Petals : This forms the second inner whorl. Petals are the large, fragrant and brightly coloured part of the flower.

Anthers : It is located in the third whorl of the flower. The filament of the stamen bears the anther at its tip.

Stigma : It is located in the fourth and the innermost whorl of the flower. The ~~stigma~~ style bears the stigma at its tip.
