

A drainage basin or river basin is an area which is drained by a single river system.

Reason

ans → River system are the patterns formed by the streams, rivers and lakes in a particular drainage basin.

Water divide is an elevated area which separates two drainage basins.

HIMALAYAN RIVERS

- ⇒ The Himalayan Rivers are glacier origin.
- ⇒ The Himalayan Rivers are perennial rivers as they are glacier origin & flow throughout the year.
- ⇒ The Himalayan Rivers are long course of rivers whereas perennial rivers are shallow course of rivers.
- ⇒ The major rivers are the Ganga, Indus & Brahmaputra are known as northern flowing rivers.
- ⇒ The peninsular Rivers are seasonal rivers.
- ⇒ As the peninsular Rivers are seasonal rivers which depend on southwest monsoon & retreating monsoon.
- ⇒ Perennial rivers are shallow coarse of rivers.
- ⇒ The major rivers are Mahanadi, Krishna, Kaveri, Godavari, Narmada & Tapi are western flowing rivers.
