1) Read the given extract and answer the questions that follow.

(a) What made the young seagull scream?

(Ans) The seagull was quite hungry and yearned for food. When he saw a piece of fish in the beak of his mother, he suddenly dived at the fish forgetting that he didn't know how to fly and uttered a scream falling outwards and downwards into space.

(b) How long did the young seagull's fear last?

(c) How did he feel later?

(Ans) The next moment he felt his wings spread outwards. The wind rushed against his great feathers, then under his stomach, and against his wings.

(d) Find out the antonym of 'upwards' from the passage.

(Ans) The word is 'downwards'.

(2) Answer the following questions in about 30-40 words each.

(a) What was the young seagull afraid of? Why was he not able to fly?

(Ans) The young seagull was afraid of flying. He was not able to fly because he thought that his wings would not support him. He would fall.

(b) What did the young seagull watch about his brothers all day long?

(Ans) The young seagull watched his parents flying about with his brothers and sister, perfecting them in the art of flight, teaching them how to dive for fish. His brothers were being praised by his parents for learning the flight.

(c) How did the young seagull react when his mother flew across to him with a piece of fish?

(Ans) The young seagull leaned out eagerly, tapping the rock with his feet, trying to get nearer to his mother as she flew across so that he could take the food in his mouth.

(d) What was the mother seagull doing standing on the plateau and why?

(Ans) The mother of the young seagull was sitting on the plateau and eating the piece of fish in order to lure her son. This was her trick to trap her son to come to her for food and for that he would have to fly.
