Permanent Executive

* Executives who are elected by the people for a specific period are called Political Executive.

* The permanent executives are salaried with civil servants who are appointed on a long term.

* Example - Political leaders like the Prime Minister, Council of Ministers.

* Person working in civil service. Example - IAS, IPS and IFS

* They remain in office only so long as they command the

* They remain in office even when the ruling party changes. Their -

- confidence of the majority members of the parliament. - tenure of the office is fixed.

* They are answerable to people for all the consequences of their decisions.

* They are ~~not~~ not answerable to the people.

* They are more powerful. They take all the final decisions.

* They are less powerful. They do not take decisions. Instead they assist political executives in carrying out day-to-day administration.
