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Q1. Skeletal muscular tissue - bones
visceral muscular tissue - G.I tract, uterus, eye, blood vessels
cardiac muscular tissue - heart

Q2. involuntary muscles are muscles which conduct all the involuntary ~~act~~ processes in our body - ex- digestion, they are found in uterus, G.I tract, eyes and blood vessel.

Q3. straighted muscles are muscles which are attached to our bones, their function is movement and posture. Smooth muscles are muscles which perform involuntary ~~act~~ processes like blinking, breathing.
