

2. WHICH COLOURS ARE ASSIGNED TO MOUNTAIN, PLAINS AND WATERBODIES? 2 MARKS

Answer

The three types of Scale are:-

1. Ratio Scale (1:1450,000) :-

A fractional Scale map shows the fraction of an object or land feature feature on the map. This type uses a set of numbers that represent the object or a landmark. As an example on the left photo, the orange - shaded scale represents a $\frac{2}{3}$ fractional scale.

Q. * A line Scale Shows the distance between two or more prominent landmarks. The linear Scale on maps is a set of lines or dots that represents a landmark. An example



On the left photo is a map with a linear scale on each road.

* Verbal Scale:

This type of scale uses simple words to describe a prominent surface feature. A verbal scale expands abbreviations to describe a landmark on an object. An example is the image to the left describes a scale as cm is equal to 15 kilometers.

2. ANSI - * Mountains indicates the brown & green

* Green indicates the plain.

* blue indicates the water bodies
