3. Taxes were levied by traders and farmers.  
Cattle and Sheep herders paid taxes in the forms of animals and animals products.

4. Bimbisara belonged to the Haryanka dynasty. A capable ruler, he set up an excellent administrative system and built an extensive network of roads and communication. He patronised the Saigas, and as King, he and both the Jain and the Buddhists claimed him as their devotee. He strengthened his position by annexing the neighbouring state of Anga.
