(Q) Define :

(1) Temperature is the SI unit of temperature?

(2) What are different scales of temperature?

Answers

1. The temperature is the measure of degree of hotness or coldness of an object. The S.I. unit of temperature is Kelvin (Symbol K).

2. There are three temperature scales in use today, Fahrenheit, Celsius & Kelvin. Fahrenheit temperature scale is a scale based on 32 for the freezing point of water & 212 for the boiling point of water, the interval between the two being divided into 180 parts.
