In the styles group, display the full Quick styles gallery

Choose the command Create a style

In the Name box, type a short and descriptive name for your style.

Click the OK button to create the style

Explain any four Graphic filters?

Smooth → It reduces the differences between adjacent pixels, resulting in a slight lack of sharpness, and if the filter is used many times in any row, the effect will be strengthened and intensified.

Sharpen → This will increase the differences between the adjacent pixels, which will confirm the difference in brightness, and this will show outlines and strengthen the effect when applying the filter more than once in a row.

each pixel is compared to the pixel next to it, and the value that deviates in color from the average value is replaced by another pixel of medium value, then the resulting graphics are recognized.

The pop → Art filter is supposed to change the image colours to pop art form but it is not working as required at this time.

Explain Image Cropping.

Cropping is the removal of unnecessary areas from a photographic or illustrated image. Depending on the application, this can be performed on a physical photograph or artwork, film footage, or it can be achieved digitally by using image editing software.
