Banyan tree

The national tree of India is the Banyan tree. The Banyan tree is huge from outside and sends new shoots from its underlying foundations, making the tree a knot of branches, roots and trunks. The existence of the Banyan tree is extremely long and is considered an everlasting tree. The biggest Banyan tree in India lives at the Indian Botanical Garden in Shibpur, Howrah in West Bengal. It is around 25 m tall, and the shelter cover is around 420 m with more than 2000 elevated roots. Banyan trees are perhaps the biggest tree on the planet and grow up to 20-25 m with branches spreading up to 100 m. It has an enormous trunk that has smooth greyish earthy coloured bark and is bluted. The plant might be killed inside a lot more limited size by an uncommon strategy known as the Bonsai.
