First Person narration :- All most all paragraphs of the narration are started with 'I' that is "First Person". Author narrated the story keeping himself at the beginning of ~~the~~ each paragraph.

Use of spoken language - including long sentences and increased use of the word "and" :-

Author used a lot of spoken language in the narration and also used the word "and"

more times in a sentence. As an example, ~~at~~ in 'Paragraph four', at first sentence author used "and" more than two times.

Speech addressed directly to the reader :-

In the entire narration author has addressed the whole issue directly to the readers in a simple and spoken language, which is easily understood by readers.
