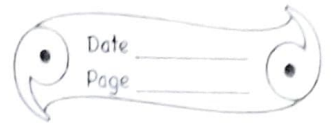

Q- A bat and a bird can fly, yet they are different from each other - other. How?

Ans- While both birds and bats fly by flapping wings in a down-and-forward way to generate lift, the main difference comes from the bat's use of additional 'fingers'. The wings of a bird are comprised of elongated arms with a single finger on the end. This allows a bat to have a better range of motion in its flying.
