Q) Write about the political conditions that developed in India during 1920's. In 1920's was the series of events-

→ In 1920, in the Calcutta session of the Congress, Gandhiji convinced other leaders to start a non-cooperation movement.

→ Aims: Mahatma Gandhi and Shakti Ali toured extensively, mobilising popular support for the movement.

→ In June 1920, Jawahar Nehru began going around the villages in Awadh, talking to the villagers and trying to understand the grievance.

→ In the Gudem hills of Andhra Pradesh, for instance, a militant guerrilla movement was spread. Here, the colonial govt. had closed large forest areas, preventing people from entering the forests to graze their cattle, or collect fuelwood and fruits.
