Q1. What do you mean by coming together Federalism?

Ans Route involves independent states coming together on their own to form a bigger unit, so that by pooling sovereignty and retaining identity they can increase their security. This is called coming together Federalism.

Q2. What do you mean by holding together Federalism?

Ans Route where a large country decides to divide its power between the constituent states and the national government. Here central government tends to be more powerful vis-a-vis the state. This is called holding together Federalism.

Q3. Define Union List?

Ans Union List includes subjects of national importance. The Union Government alone can make laws relating to the subjects mentioned in the Union List.

Q4. Define State List?

Ans State List contains subjects of State and local importance. The state Governments alone can make laws relating to the subjects mentioned in the state List.

Q5. Define Concurrent List?

Ans Concurrent List includes subjects of common interest to both the Union Government as well as the state Governments. Both the Union as well as the state Governments can make laws.

Q6. Define Residuary ~~subjects~~ List?

Ans Residuary List includes the subjects that do not fall in any of the three lists. The Union Government has the power to legislate on these 'residuary' subjects.
