

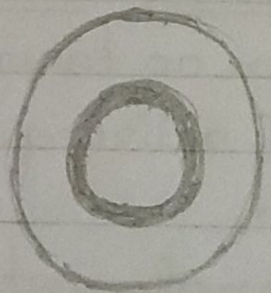
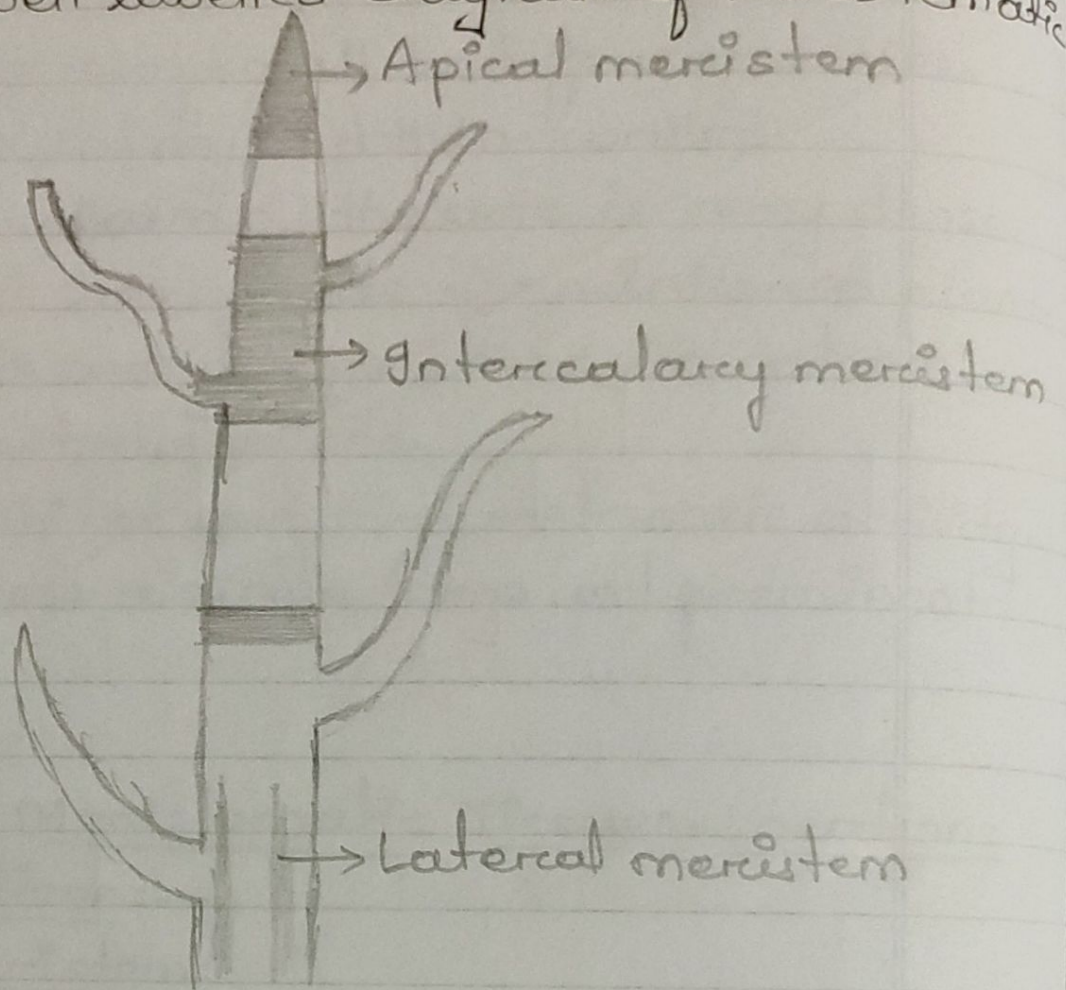
1. Define tissues.
