② Socialist:-

the ownership of land and industry to reduce socio-economic inequalities.

③ Secular:-

Citizens have complete freedom to follow any religion. But there is no official religion. Govt. treats all religious beliefs and practices with equal respect.

④ Democratic:-

A form of govt. where people enjoy equal political rights, elect their rulers and hold them accountable. The govt. is run according to some basic rules.

⑤ Republic:-

The head of the state is an elected person and not a hereditary one.
