


Biology - Homework



1) Write 2 differences between blood and lymph?

Blood

Blood is red in colour due to presence of haemoglobin.

Lymph

Lymph is colourless due to absence of RBC.

It moves from heart and towards the heart.

It moves in 1 direction (tissues to sub-clavians)

2) How do bone differ from cartilage?

Bone

matrix consists of tough, inflexible material called ossein.

Bone is highly vascular

Bone have narrow bone marrow at centre.

Cartilage

matrix is composed of firm and flexible material called chondrin.

Cartilage is non-vascular.

Bone - marrow is absent in cartilage.

3) What is main function of muscle tissue?

Main function of muscle tissues are :-

- Responsible for movement in our body
- The maintenance of body shape.
