

1) Vladimir Lenin was leader of Bolshevik party?

Father Gapon led a procession of workers which reached the winter palace whence they were attacked by police and cossacks. Over 100 workers were killed and 300 wounded. This incident was known as the Bloody Sunday.

The elected consultative parliament after the 1905 revolution of Russia came to be known as Duma.

The result of 1905 revolution of Russia was that, Tsar Nicholas II allowed the creation of an elected consultative parliament or Duma.

3> 1) The year 1904 was a particularly bad for Russian workers. Prices of essential goods rose so quickly that real wages were declined by 20%.

The membership of workers association rose dramatically. When four members of the assembly of Russian workers were dismissed at the Putilov iron works, there was a call for industrial action.

Over the next few years days over 1,10,000 workers in St. Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction of working day to eight hours, an increase in wages and improvement in working conditions.

Father Gapon led a procession of workers who reached the winter palace where it was attacked by the police and cossacks.

Over 100 workers killed & about 300 wounded. This incident is known as Bloody Sunday.

All people from different parts of country like students, lawyers, doctors, engineers joined the strike and established the union of unions and demanded a constituent assembly.

This were the reasons / cause of 1905 Revolution in Russia.
