- 1) The peace treaty at Versailles with the Allies was a harsh and humiliating treaty. Justify.

The peace treaty at Versailles with the Allies was a harsh and humiliating treaty because by signing this treaty Germany suffered the major loss.

Some of the great losses of Germany were :-

- * Germany lost its overseas countries, one tenth of the population, 13% of its territories, 75% of its iron, 26% of its coal to France, Poland, Denmark and Lithuania.
- * The Allied powers demilitarised Germany to weaken its power.
- * The war guilt clause held Germany responsible for the war and damages suffered by the Allied powers.

* Germany was forced to pay compensation of 6 billion.

* The Allied armies also occupied the resource-rich Rhineland for much of the 1920's.
