


De The peace treaty at Verisailles with the Allies was a harsh and humilating treaty.

Justify.

The peace treaty at Versailles with the Allies was a harsh and humillating treaty because by signing this treaty Fermany suffered the major loss.

Some of the great losses of Germany were:

- Fermany lost its overseas countries, one tenth of the population, 13% of its territories, 75% of its irron, 26% of its coal to France, Poland, Denmark and 13thunia.
- * The Allied powers demilitarised Germany to weaken its powers.
- The war guilt clause held Ferrmany responsible for the war and damages suffered by the Allied powers



* Germany was forced to pay compensation of 6 billion.
