APPLE → Ariane Passenger Payload Experiment

- 1> APPLE was India's first communication satellite.
- 2> It is a geostationary satellite.
- 3> It was launched by Ariane 1, from Kourou, French Guiana on June 19, 1981.
- 4> APPLE was dedicated to the Nation on August 13, 1981 by then former Prime Minister Mrs. Indira Gandhi.
- 5> The Prime Minister's address to the Nation on August 15 from the Red Fort was carried live by APPLE.
