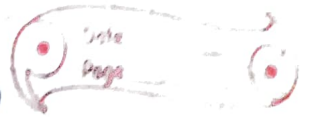
1 The most successful club of France was the Jacobin club. Jacobins publicly declared the end of oppressive rule of king.
