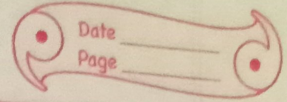

1) Define the term constitution?

Ans → A constitution is a set of rules, laws and principles according to which a country is governed.

2) What are the three organs of the Government?

Ans → The three organs of the government are:

- the legislature
- the Executive
- the judiciary

3) What is meant by dissent?

Ans → If a law goes against the interests of a group of people, then that group will protest to express its dissatisfaction.

4) What do you mean by Rule of Law?

Ans → Violation of these laws was made punishable and no one was above the law. So if anyone broke the law he or she would be liable to be punished - irrespective of caste, class, creed or gender.

5) When can a law be declared as null and void by a court?

ANS → IF a law is enacted against the principle of the constitution, then the judiciary has the right to declare it null and void.
