Q1 (1) what do you mean by coming together federalism?

ans. Independent states join together on their own to form a larger unit called as coming together federalism. the central govt and the state have equal powers.

(2) What do you mean by holding together federalism?

ans. when a large country chooses to divide its authority between the member states and central govt; is called holding together federalism. here the central govt. tends to be more powerful.

(3) Define union list.

ans. union list includes subjects of national importance such as defence of country, foreign affairs, banking, communications and currency. The union government alone can make laws relating to the subjects mentioned in the union list.

(4) Define State list .

ans- State list contains subject of state and local importance such as police , trade , commerce , agriculture and irrigation . The state government alone can make laws relating to the subjects mentioned in the state list .

(5) Define concurrent list -

ans- Concurrent list included subjects of common interest to both the union government as well as the state government , such as education , forest , trade unions , marriage , adoption and succession . Both the union as well as the state government can make laws on the subject mentioned in the list , if their laws conflicts with each other , the law made by the Union government will prevail .

(6) Define Residuary list .

ans- Subjects like computers software that came up after the constitution was made . According to our constitution the union government has the power to legislate on these residuary subjects .
