1. How does the narrator describe the school master?

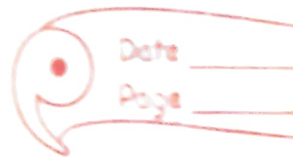
Ans = The narrator describe the school master as 'cruel eye out worn'.
